The Rusty Bucket - Joanne Engelhaupt



The Rusty Bucket raises goats, meat chickens and grows microgreens. She supplies health food stores, grocery stores, along with restaurants with microgreens, goat meat and fresh produce. Her commercial kitchen allows her to make and sell other food products besides her microgreens. In her spare time, she likes to repurpose and give new life to old homestead finds.

Our Wyoming Life Farm Store – Erin & Mike Galloway

Erin & Mike Galloway raise cattle and vegetables and sell items at the Farmers Market and their new farm store. They also have a YouTube Channel - Our Wyoming Life - that features regular posts about every day ranch life.



High Plains Grower – Bob & Rita Jordan



Bob and Rita Jordan have several high tunnels so they can raise vegetables almost year-round. Bob is partnering with other growers to expand the produce available regionally. His goal is to have 10,000 pounds of produce a year available.

J Walker Land & Livestock – Jason & Jenna Walker

Jason & Jenna Walker raise grassfed beef and sell at the farmers markets and other marketing outlets. Their beef jerky can be found in grocery stores and gas stations. They purchased a trailer to house their freezers to enhance their direct marketing efforts.
